KLASSI BERTI was allowed to settle early, rallied in the upper stretch on the rail, had a perfect trip and drew clear, driving. PETCH stalked the pace, rallied at the quarter pole, was outfinished late but held place. PRECIOUS DUKE set the pace and dueled on the lead from the inside, held well in the stretch. TURNPIKE MIKE pressed the pace four wide, went evenly late. PRINCE OF PAULIE had good position for a half, lacked a late response. GETALONG was no factor. LUCKY DRAGON was through early.
