PYRITE SPRINGS unhurried for five furlongs, moved up steadily four wide, made the lead at the top of the stretch and proved best in a stretch long drive. READY FOR ROSES outrun for six furlongs, closed with a burst of speed five wide and just missed getting up in time. BUG HUNTER well back for five and one half furlongs, dropped along the rail entering the stretch, bid to be on near even terms for the lead at the eighth pole, matched strides with the winner

and was outfinished in a game effort. DONTSHOOTTHEMSNGR close up from the start along the inside, went evenly. SIDNEY'S SHAM pressed the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way late. PREMIER COURT away alertly, set the pace until the top of the stretch then tired. JACHOVIA was outrun. IMPERIAL SKY was no threat. BROOKS BLACH was through after six furlongs. RUBIUS pressed the pace for six furlongs then flattened out. WHAT THE DEVIL was through early. J HALL offered little. CAST NO SHADOW was no factor. FIERCE CAT flashed speed and stopped.
