COBRA LADY made the lead while leaving the chute, set the balance of the pace, turned back a mild bid from FLY AWAY ANGEL at the eighth pole and proved best under brisk handling. FLY AWAY ANGEL had speed from the start between horses, improved position on the turn, dropped along the inside entering the stretch, sustained her bid to the eighth pole drawing on near even terms for the lead then finished second best. SHANNONS VALENTINE pressed the winner three wide into the stretch then was outfinished. CLEVER MISS TRIXIE passed tiring horses while no threat. GOLD MARGARITA broke a step slow, bid on the turn then came up empty. READY AND TOUGH had speed for a half then gave way. CROW JANE bore in at the start then made the lead briefly while drifting out leaving the chute, remained a sharp factor along the rail into the turn, steadied just before the five sixteenths pole while in tight then stopped the final eighth.
