THAT'S SO ROMANTIC never far back in the early going, rallied in the upper stretch, split horses and drew clear late under strong handling. FOXWOOD ANNIE was away alertly and set the pace, could not match strides with the winner late, but was second best. OLA BOO BOO pressed the pace, needed more late, finished willingly and was best of the rest. CLASSY ETBAUER allowed to settle, failed to menace. OHIO VOLUNTEER was never a threat. SPICY COLONY contended for a half, then retreated.
