Footnotes

EYES SUPER FREAKY was well placed on the inside down the backside, angled out three wide at the top of the stretch, quickly drew off through the lane under steady urging. LICENSE TO BLING pressed the pace and dueled on the lead, could not match strides with the winner through the stretch but was second best. UNCLE VIRGIL allowed to settle early, had a mild rally through the stretch on the inside while no threat. MERCER'S MARK was unhurried early, had a mild bid in the stretch while no threat. DIAVOLETTA was in tight at the start, quickly gained the lead and set the pace until the second turn, then faltered in the stretch. RUDYARD K allowed to settle early, passed tiring rivals while no threat. ALL SNUFFED UP raced close up for three quarters, faltered

in the in the stretch. MIDNIGHT VADER stumbled at the start and did not threaten. KIPLING BOY raced mid pack for seven furlongs, had no rally. BRASS BUCKLE came in slightly after the start on the inside causing DOCTOR DIEGO to check, then was no threat. RISKY ROMANCE never far back early, gave way in the stretch. RED FRANCHISE pressed the early pace three wide, dropped back on the second turn, lost contact in the stretch and was eased through the wire. DOCTOR DIEGO well placed on the inside soon after start checked hard and lost his irons and was eased. THE STEWARDS POSTED THE INQUIRY SIGN BUT TOOK NO ACTION.
