HARLAN'S HOLIDAY dueled for the lead for a half, gained the advantage entering the stretch and widened to the wire while being ridden out. TRUTH MATTERS never far back, came four wide through the stretch and rallied to get up for second. ALL STAR LOVER set the pace for a half and gradually weakened. HIGHLAND RIM disputed the pace into the stretch and gave way. CRYPTO'S TWINJET well placed, lacked a closing response. DINKERS MILLENNIUM ducked in at the start and had a mild late rally. WATCH ME FIRE offered little. PROOFISINTHEPUDDIN had speed for three furlongs and stopped. MERCER'S LAUNCH flashed speed and flattened out. BAREFOOT JERRY was always outrun.
