COCONUT HALL always within striking distance, slipped through along the rail on the turn, engaged the leaders entering the stretch then proved best in a stretch long drive. HORSE CALLED MUSIC prompted the pace three wide from the start, drew on even terms for the lead at the top of the stretch, dug in gamely and just missed. EVE THE DANCER unhurried early, had a mild late rally along the rail. FRAZIER'S FINEST went evenly. U LUCKY GIRL sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, set the pace into the stretch, ducked out at the eighth pole and weakened. MOLINARO MISSION broke in a tangle and was through early.
