LITTLE SHNUCK stalked early three wide dueled from the quarter pole through the stretch, prevailed after a long drive, gamely. MADE THE STEAL dueled on the lead the entire trip, held gamely in the stretch and just missed. BUSCANDO FORTUNA was never far back early, rallied three wide in the stretch, finished well and was gaining. BAATESH raced middle of the pack, lacked a late bid and went evenly. ITS ON FIRE vied for the lead, weakened in the stretch. QUICK CASH allowed to settle, failed to menace. WOOD ALLEY was never a threat. STAY IN LINE saved ground and tired. PRESSOR raced wide and was outrun.
