TILTAM SPIN stalked the pace, rallied three wide in the stretch, drew clear late, driving. DOUBLE NAUGHT SPY was unhurried early, rallied five wide in the stretch, finished well and was up for second. HOUBARA pressed the pace four wide, finished willingly. FORT SHAME set the pace with a clear lead, faltered in mid stretch. SHIFTIN GEARS well placed and saved ground, put in a bid in mid stretch, then hung. GENERAL LAFAYETTE slow early, passed tiring rivals. DR. FRANKLIN raced middle of the pack and was no threat. DOUBLE OH FIVE was through after a half. BEER AND BULLET'S never far back, had no late bid. SUNSHINE BOB raced wide and was outrun. C B SPICY DUCK raced wide, lost ground on the turn and was outrun.
