FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$350 by Saturday July 1, 2006, Or all horses which have started in Graded Stakes at any Magna Tracks in 2006 shall receive a Free Nomination. Supplementary nominations accepted to the Ohio Derby of \$7,500 due by Tuesday July 11, 2006, \$1,750 to enter and \$1,750 additional to start with \$350,000 Guaranteed, of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 5% to fourth; 3% to fifth; and 2% to sixth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-Winners of \$100,000 twice at a mile or over in 2006 allowed 3 lbs; of \$100,000 at a mile or over in 2006; 6 lbs; of \$100,000 at any distance 9 lbs; of \$50,000 at any distance 12 lbs. (MCOS not considered in weight allowances) The Ohio Derby will be limited to fourteen (14) Starters, in the event more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box by 10:30 A.M. Eastern Standard Time, Wednesday July 12, 2006, preference will be given to those horses having accumulated the highest lifetime earnings at the time of closing entries. Lifetime earnings will be determined according to statistics provided by Equibase. A Trophy to the winning Owner, Trainer & Jockey.

Footnotes

DEPUTY GLITTERS was well placed for the opening half mile, advanced with a move in the upper stretch and prevailed in a long stretch drive in a game effort. HIGH COTTON stalked the pace to the top of the lane, battled from the inside DEPUTY GLITTERS to the wire but was unable to overcome the winners advantage. FLASHY BULL was a bit rank in the opening quarter while racing towards the rear, offered a bid nearing the final turn from along the rail, came out to find room in mid stretch, then angled in to the rail for a slight advance but needed more late. SACRED LIGHT was never far back while racing on the outside, was three wide along the backstretch and into the second turn but lacked a late response. SAYHELLOTOLARRY was well placed in opening half while saving ground then gave way shortly thereafter and was unable to mount a rally. TRI UIMET sprinted clear to set a moderate pace, held his advantage to the final turn then faltered badly through the stretch.
