GIRLISH GIGGLE unhurried while trailing into the first turn, responded readily when set down entering the second turn, picked up rivals four wide into the stretch, made the lead just before the sixteenth pole while under left handed urging and drew clear. BARNSY pressed the pace three wide into the second turn, made the lead, set the pace until deep stretch then could not handle the winner. GOLDEN TOUR made the lead soon after the start, set the pace into the second turn, dug in when headed but was outfinished. PATTI'S CLOWN pressed the pace along the rail into the second turn then gradually weakened. IMAHONEYTOO well placed, lacked a closing response. OH SO EASY failed to menace. WHITEWATER WAY trailed.
