DARING HABIT vied for the lead, drew clear in the stretch under firm handling. COOL RAIN FALLING well placed throughout, rallied three wide in mid stretch and was second best. SILVER LABEL vied for the lead, held well in the stretch. CALL LEADER had good position, lacked a late kick and went evenly. AL FAASIL slow early, had a steady advance. STORM SEARCH failed to menace. HOLLOR BACK well placed early, was through after a half. AMERICAN ALL STAR raced wide and was always outrun. HIGH END PROSPECT broke slowly, rushed to contention, tired in the stretch. PETER'S PUDDLES trailed.
