OH SO EASY settled just off the leaders three wide into the far turn, responded readily when set down, made the lead inside the furlong marker and finished full of run under right handed urging to win going away. ASHWOOD C C broke inward bumping with BOLARO at the start, made the lead at the six furlong pole, set the pace until deep stretch then could not handle the winner. WHITEWATER WAY was taken in hand to tail into the stretch then rallied steadily four wide. GOLDEN TOUR pressed the pace into the stretch then gave way. HEAVENLY JET set the pace around the first turn, had speed into the stretch then flattened out. BOLARO broke outward bumping with ASHWOOD C C then was through after a half.
