Footnotes

EL SUPREMO prompted the pace along the inside for a half, responded with a quick move when set down entering the stretch, opened up a daylight lead before the eighth pole and won under energetic handling. LUCCIROCKINBUCCI never far back, rallied determinedly five wide and finished clear for second. JUST MIKE sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, set the pace into the stretch then was outfinished. SOUP FOR TWO went evenly. CAMP BUBBA vied for the lead into the stretch then weakened slightly. STRANGELET had speed for a half six wide then gradually weakened. CHALK EYED CAT was not a threat. KRIS'S HONOR offered little. SHOULDNTUBDOINTHIS trailed and passed tiring horses. POOR TO FAIR was outrun. FLIGHTWITHOUTWINGS had brief speed.
