JEANNE'S HERO stalked the pace, rallied in the stretch three wide, prevailed late, driving. T. T.'S SURPRISE was well placed and saved ground, angled out four wide in mid stretch, closed fast and just missed. RESULTA stalked the early pace, rallied at the quarter pole and gained the lead, was outfinished late. SILKY TAB raced five wide and went evenly. REAPINGTHEREWARDS slow early, improved her position while no threat. LITTLE FRUIT FLY had good early speed, weakened in the stretch. OHIO VOLUNTEER raced middle of the pack and was no threat. CLODY was no factor. M C'S STAR was through early.
