BOROBETA stalked the early pace, rallied in the upper stretch, drew off in late stretch while being ridden out. DINKERS VALENTINE set the pace and dueled for the lead while saving ground, was no match for the winner late but held place. QUICK VERDICT unhurried early, rallied four wide through the lane and just missed second. NO EXPOSURE never far back, did not mount a bid. JILL'S CAT outrun early, never reached contention. WANNA TRY ME pressed the pace and dueled for the lead, flattened out in the stretch. PAINT MY DREAMS had good position, came up empty in the stretch. DUAL DIAGNOSIS was through after a half.
