CHIEF INSPECTOR was never far back and saved ground, angled out four wide in mid stretch, closed deternienly and was up in the final stride. ROYALDISH stalked the pace, rallied in mid stretch, led between calls late and just missed. AL FAASIL stalked the pace, rallied at the quarter pole and gained a slight lead, put in his bid and was outfinished. THEYCALLMEADREAMER raced four wide and had a mild bid. DUKE SKYWALKER had good early speed, faltered in the stretch. DAN LITTLE MAN was no factor. CHARLES LARKE had brief foot on the inside and quickly faded.
