EMILY SUN SHINE sprinted up along the inside to make the lead soon after the start, set a pressured pace all the way and edged clear late under strong encouragement. SUPER INDEED pressured the winner three wide all the way and gamely held on for second. D'WILD DAY dropped along the rail, lacked racing room nearing the quarter pole then finished evenly. CRYING THE BLUES offered a mild bid four wide into the stretch then leveled off. SAVANNAH SINGS stalked the pace into the stretch then faded. NORMANDY QUEEN raced widest of all and went evenly. UNBIASED raced without her best action while trailing wide and returned sore. COLERAINE dueled for the early lead between horses and stopped entering the turn.
