MATZ made the lead soon after the start, set the balance of the pace and widened through the stretch to win as much the best while being ridden out. COASTAL SURGE chased the winner all the way and finished clear for second. FLOATMEALLOAN settled just off the leaders then went evenly. BIG FUN'S SON also turned in an even effort. TOP TRADER well placed, lacked a closing response. FULLBORE failed to reach contention. MY SECRET LIGHT was outrun. TRIPLE SCORPIO was not a threat. BOOGIDY SHOO trailed. VALZEE settled well back and broke down twenty yards before the wire. The stewards posted the inquiry sign but took no action
