MISSED THE PROM dueled for the early lead on the inside, gained a clear lead at the quarter pole, widened in the lane while being ridden out. MCCALMONT stalked the pace, rallied stretch, was no match for the winner but was clearly second best. CALL LEADER wide early, had a mild bid while no threat. RIGHT NICE allowed to settle early, swung wide and had a mild rally while no threat. GI'S SECOND CHANCE well placed and saved ground, lacked a late response. JACKETY JACK well placed for a half, weakened in the stretch. AL FAASIL was no factor. SERAFIC GUY raced mid pack and was no threat. SWEEPING SILK chased the winner for a half, gave way in the stretch. BONNRITA wide early, was outrun. SKYLAR'S DADDY was no factor. The rider of GIS SECOND CHANCE claimed foul against the rider of MISSED THE PROM for alledged inference down the backside. After viewing the tape the stewards took no action.
