EXCESSIVELYCASUAL set the pace under pressure for almost a half, gave up the lead to BLUE REALITY on the turn, was well handled to prevent bumping that one in upper stretch, dug in late and got back up in time. BLUE REALITY prompted the pace while along the rail into the turn, assumed command, set the pace until deep stretch then could not handle the winner. TINY IRISH DANCER settled just off the leaders and went evenly. PIRATE'S GEM well placed, failed to respond. VAL'S GIRL was outrun. STARR OF HONOR was never involved. CAPRICIOUSNESS trailed.
