JOHNNY MAESTRO sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, set the balance of the pace and proved best in a stretch long drive. TALE OF THE COURT prompted the pace three wide and finished second best. HOUBARA settled just off the leaders then went evenly. DR. FRANKLIN well placed, lacked a closing response. BEHRLY JUMPIN passed tiring rivals late. MAESTRO AND MASTER was a sharp threat for a half then weakened. SUNSHINE BOB swung wide while never a threat. TRUST AND HONOR was no factor. SHIFTIN GEARS had brief speed. DOUBLE OH FIVE was through early. ITZA MAKER trailed and was eased to the wire.
