MIG ALLEY unhurried early while inside, angled out to the middle of the racetrack at the top of the stretch, closed fast and got up in the final strides. B SHARP had speed from the start three wide, made the lead in mid stretch then just missed hanging on. WRONG NUMBER was hustled to the lead along the inside soon after the start, set the pace until mid stretch, dug in gamely but was outfinished. BROTHER BRETT found his best stride too late. CHO was a sharp threat four wide into the stretch, was forced wide and dropped out of it. OVER QUALIFIED had speed for three eighths then tired. WATCH ME GO BYEBYE was outrun. SMOKIN SURPRISE prompted the pace between horses into the turn, lugged out nearing the quarter pole and stopped.
