POLISH MON was allowed to settle early, rallied second turn on the inside, closed determienly and edged clear late. RARE MARK set the pace with a clear lead through moderate fractions, held well in the lane and just missed. BELLAMY'S THUNDER pressed the pace on the inside, angled out upper stretch three wide, put in his bid, then hung late. ABOUNDING GRACE unhurried early, rallied in the upper stretch four wide but needed more. MO' TERMS slow early, saved ground on the second turn and had a mild bid. HARD KNOCKIN ROBYN failed to menace. IGOTCHANOW pressed the pace while between horses, tired after five eights. CAT SQUALLS pressed the pace three wide, gave way on the second turn.
