UNTOUCHED always within striking distance while hung outside rivals, responded readily when set down on the second turn, made the lead out in the five path in deep stretch and drew off. CUYAHOGA RIVER settled just behind the leaders for five furlongs, angled three wide and made the lead near the quarter pole, drew clear then could not handle the winner late. MISS MUTAK well back for five furlongs, had a mild late rally behind the winner and finished on even terms with KILLARNEY MIST at the wire. KILLARNEY MIST well placed, offered a mild bid before the second turn then leveled off. DR. JESS JR pressed the pace two wide into the stretch then gradually weakened. ABBY RENAE away alertly, set a pressured pace into the second turn then weakened. POLITE COMPANY was no factor. FORMAL WHO was through after a half.
