THATS OUR LUCK dueled for the lead for five furlongs, shook clear on the second turn, widened through the lane while being ridden out. MOJAVE HAWK was allowed to settle, rallied on the second turn, was no match for the winner through the stretch, but was second best. GAITERO allowed to settle, had a mild bid while no threat. POR SUPUESTO dueled with the winner for five furlongs, gave way in the stretch. STORM SEARCH stalked the pace, had no late bid. TWICE BID was never in contention. WILD CHARGER was no factor. RUSSIAN WILD LIFE showed little in a dull effort. MIDNIGHT TORNADO raced between horses and dropped back.
