RIGHT ON stalked the pace, rallied in mid stretch, drew clear late under firm handling. HOT PROPOSITION was well placed early, rallied three wide in the stretch and finished gamely for second. MARCO REGS WINNER set the pace with a clear lead, was outfinished. GENERAL LAFAYETTE off a step slow and was allowed to settle, had a middle move five wide with a strong bid, then leveled off. HUBBERT'S PEAK slow early, improved his position while no threat. STATE OF THE ART never far back early, saved ground in the stretch and went evenly. RAGASCO raced middle of the pack, had no rally. SPIDERMANDATE was through after a half. FULL GRAND close up for five furlongs, gave way on the second turn.
