SURE TO WIN was unhurried early, rallied in the upper stretch five wide, closed detemriently and prevailed by the narrowest of margins. HORSE CALLED MUSIC was well placed and saved ground, angled out and rallied in mid stretch, closed stoutly and just missed. DIURNAL was away alertly and set the pace with a clear lead, remained clear in mid stretch and was caught late. TRES LUCIA allowed to settle, swung wide in the stretch and rallied. ELLS APPLAUSE well placed and saved ground, went evenly. DOLLYS STORM had good position throughout, lacked a rally. LAMEECE pressed the pace, tired in mid stretch. KATCHUM AN KISSUM trailed.
