Weight: 124 lbs. Non-Winners of \$60,000 twice at a mile or over in 2010 allowed 2 lbs; of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2010; 4 lbs; of \$60,000 at any distance 6 lbs. (MCOSnot considered in weight allowances). The Ohio Derby will be limited to fourteen (14) Starters, in the event more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box by 10:30 A.M. Eastern Standard Time, Tuesday July 27, 2010, preference will be given to those horses having accumulated the highest lifetime earnings at the time of closing entries. Lifetime earnings will be determined according to statistics provided by Equibase. A Trophy to the winning Owner, Trainer & Jockey.

**Footnotes**

PLEASANT PRINCE always within striking distance while racing three wide, moved up steadily on the second turn and into the stretch, dug in late to split horses inside the sixteenth pole and was up in the final strides. WORLDLY hung five wide on the first turn, stalked the pace four wide into the stretch, responded making the lead in deep stretch and just missed hanging on. CAPITOL APPEAL four wide on the first turn, vied for the lead into the stretch, drew on even terms for the lead at the eighth pole, bumped with MYKINDACANDY while matching strides and then was outfinished despite a game effort. MYKINDACANDY prompted the pace two wide around the first turn, made the lead before a half, set a pressured pace into the stretch, dug in when joined by CAPITOL APPEAL, exchanged bumps with that one and weakened late. SLEWZOOM away alertly, set a pressured pace for a half, had speed into the stretch then weakened. MAX SILVERHAMMER passed tiring rivals while no threat. DIXIE BAND three wide on the first turn, offered a mild bid on the second turn then came up empty. SCOTTKEITH'SKITTEN had brief speed. BROKE BY NOON checked behind rivals on the first turn then failed to reach contention. CHOCHO JR. was through after a half.
