CHUCKS A DEVILGIRL outrun into the stretch, closed with a rush four wide and was up in the final strides. ALANA ZOEY had speed from the start while hung three wide, rallied to make the lead entering the stretch then just missed hanging on. PYRITE BOB prompted the pace two wide, was in tight between horses entering the stretch, came in a bit a the eighth pole and finished with good courage. NAKAGAWA well placed along the rail, went evenly. OUR LAST DANCE was no factor. KNOCKOUT ROSE was hustled up to make the lead soon after the start, set a pressured pace into the stretch, drifted out just pas the quarter pole, steadied a bit at the eighth pole then weakened. PYRITE ORE was through early.
