WESTERN PIRATE close up from the start, gave up some ground on the turn then came on again through the stretch and was steadily cutting into the winners' advantage. MARTANGO unhurried for a half, had a mild late rally. ABISTRABI outrun into the stretch, had a mild late rally while no threat. TABULATE with the second flight into the stretch, failed to offer a closing response. SPORTING REBEL failed to reach a contending position. SOMETINSPECTACULAR trailed. YOU BETTER BELIEVE battled for the lead with the winner into the turn, had speed for a half then stopped.
