COMEBACK stalked the pace, rallied at the quarter pole and gained the lead, repulsed a bid in mid stretch and prevailed late, gamely. PAYING THE BILL was unhurried early, rallied on the second turn on the inside, put in his bid in mid stretch and drew even, then was outfinished. LIMOSNEYO well placed early, rallied four wide in the stretch and finished willingly. LAZYLOU CARSON never far back, rallied five wide, put in his bid, then hung. VALENTINUS well placed and saved ground, was no threat. GRAND PERFORMER had brief foot on the inside and tired. COLONIAL LEGACY set the pace with a clear lead, gave way badly in the stretch. ROB N JEFF well placed early, stopped in mid stretch.
