CAMERO broke alertly to prompt the pace all the way, drew on even terms for the lead inside the eighth pole and proved best under strong handling. TRUELY JESS made the lead soon after the start, set the pace under pressure, edged clear on the turn, dug in when challenged by the winner and just missed hanging on. AUNT JACK settled far back for a half and finished fastest of all. SISTER JOACHIM closed a gap late. METRO'S PROSPECT with the second flight into the stretch, gradually weakened. PLAYER'S HILLARY dueled for the lead for a quarter, had speed into the stretch and gave way. SHAOLIN was no factor. JUST REMEMBER WHEN was through early. SWEET LIKE HONEY was always outrun. BOOM BOX trailed throughout.
