MONTY'S TUNE just off the leaders in a stalking position in the three path, rallied determinedly through the stretch while drifting out and got up in the final strides. JOY OF BAPTISTRY sprinted up to make the lead before a quarter, set the balance of the pace, shortened stride late and just missed hanging on. EL ALTANERO chased the leader in an even effort. LEAN GREEN MACHINE was bumped by PARADE IN BRAZIL at the start, settled well back early then closed a gap late along the rail. RAT AWESOME failed to menace. PARADE IN BRAZIL broke inward bumping LEAN GREEN MACHINE at the start then was through after a half. SKIP FOR GIN was no factor. WILLIAM OF WALES had brief speed. ART'S VOICE broke alertly then then ducked out sharply and lost contact with his field on the turn.
