MORNING PRAYERS dueled early down the backside, drew clear on the turn, remained safe through the lane under a hand ride. HOW'S BAYOU was never far back, rallied in the upper stretch three wide, could not gain late on the winner but was clearly second best. ALLABOUTIMAGE (NZ) well placed and saved ground, went evenly in the stretch. HORSE CALLED MUSIC steadied while between horses down the backside, had a mild bid in the stretch. EVE THE DANCER unhurried early, swung wide and improved her position. DELLA DIAMANTE raced mid pack and did not threaten. MANDATEFOREMILY was no factor. PYRITE BOB well placed for a half, gave way in the stretch. ROMA'S GAL chased the winner for a half, tired in the stretch. JUDY MY DARLING was in tight early while between horses and was outrun.
