BATES STORM away alertly, set all the pace, lost his whip late and just lasted under a brisk hand ride. BABY SILVER had speed from the start between horses, steadied entering the turn, angled outside the winner then rallied determinedly but just missed. DARLIN I'M READY close outside, swung wide under left handed urging on the turn and finished evenly. SPECULATOR was bumped by MATELAND CLOSE at the start, went up between horses to press the pace, checked entering the turn then faded. SKIM SCAM was a sharp threat along the rail into the stretch then faded. TALE OF THE COURT was outrun. MATELAND CLOSE bore out bumping SPECUALTOR then stumbled and was through early.
