Footnotes

LARGEDOUBLEDOUBLE never far back while along the inside, angled out to the two path on the second turn, split horses in mid stretch, made the lead and was fully extended at the wire. EL GRANDE ROJO outrun for six furlongs, closed determinedly through the stretch and just missed getting up in time. SHOEFLY SHOEFLY also unhurried for six furlongs, closed a gap late. GIFTS FOR A KING settled mid pack outside rivals, rallied outside the leader to make the lead entering the stretch, dug in late but was outfinished. AFLAIR chased the leader into the second turn, drifted out at the top of the stretch brushing with BRASS BUCKLE then faded. BRASS BUCKLE was a sharp threat three wide into the stretch, was brushed by AFFLAIR and gave way. BAJHEERA set the pace for a little over six furlongs then faltered. ICE BREAKER was always outrun and eased in mid stretch.
