MASTER DAN broke sharply and pressed the pace around the first turn, rallied and drew clear at the half mile pole pole, drew off in the stretch under brisk handling. PRIVATE CASANOVA was allowed to settle and saved ground, angled out three wide in the upper stretch, rallied and was up for place. KEPLER'S VISION well placed early, chased, the winner around the far turn and in the stretch, needed more late but finished willingly. AMERICAN BUFFALO allowed to settle early, rallied in the stretch and had a steady advance. WANDO ROCK LEE allowed to settle and saved ground, was no late threat. CARTER ROAD well placed early, gave way on the second turn. MIRACLE CREEK raced mid pack and was no menace. RAPID RAMPAGE well placed early was through after a half. TALK IT OUT slow early, was always outrun. SKY KERRIDGE flashed early speed for a half, then stopped.
