ITS BINALONG TIME was unhurried early and raced in the second flight, rallied on the second turn, closed stoutly on the rail in the stretch and was up at the wire. RIGHT ON was well placed early, rallied in the upper stretch with a quick move and gained a clear lead, held gamely and just missed. EXPECT NO EQUAL allowed to settle, rallied four wide in the stretch and closed willingly. PACKER stalked the pace, rallied in the stretch and drew close, then failed to sustain his bid. BABA BOEY allowed to settle, failed to menace. WIN FOR JOE GATES had an awkward start and was never a threat. CRAFTY MARK vied for the lead for six furlongs, gave way in the stretch. MYASTORM set the pace until the quarter pole, stopped in the stretch.
