Footnotes

JEST A GENIUS prompted the pace from the start outside, gained a slight advantage on the turn, set the balance of the pace under pressure and proved best in a stiff drive. BERT'S PAL settled just off the leaders into the stretch, rallied along the rail and got up for second. POWER BALLAD never far back, rallied late between horses. NOT SO CRAFTY within striking distance from the start, was steadily gaining ground late. FIVE SIGMA EVENT closed a gap late. NEWYORKJOE away alertly, set a pressured pace into the turn, matched strides with the winner until deep stretch then weakened. JEFF'S PAPER BOOTS was no threat. NELSON HALL had brief speed. PHILOLOGY sluggish from the gate, was outrun. ACT OF DOMINANCE bobbled and bore out at the start then trailed.
