STARTIN SOMETHING pressured the pacesetting THROWS IT DOWN while three wide from the start, gave up some ground before the turn, came on again taking the leader at the top of the stretch then widened the balance of the trip to win as much the best. THROWS IT DOWN made the lead leaving the chute, set the pace until the top of the stretch, drifted out pas the middle of the racetrack through the final eighth and finished second best. MINI REWARD outrun early, altered course three wide for racing room at the three sixteenths pole then had a mild late rally. HOLLERAN went evenly. SCARLET SCRIPT failed to menace. VERNA MARIE raced inside and was through after a half. FLOPSY trailed while racing widest of all.
