Footnotes

GHOST RIDER IN RED made the lead soon after the start, set the balance of the pace and widened through the stretch to win as much the best under a strong hand ride. CLASSIC RIDGE unhurried early, rallied willingly three wide through the stretch and finished clear for second. SUPERPLUMBERBILL with the early pace three wide, gave up some ground on the turn then came on again through the stretch. SIXGUN BEAU close up along the rail, angled off the rail at the top of the stretch, steadied then dropped back towards the rail when BEAT MICHIGAN broke down at the eighth pole then finished evenly. HANLEY failed to menace. JOHNNY'S GONE bumped at the start, was outrun. GO GIOVANNI GO bumped between horses at the start, was never involved. UP IN THE CLOUDS also bumped at the start, was through early. BEAT MICHIGAN pressed the pace two wide into the stretch then broke down at the eighth pole.
