OHIO STAR had speed from the start while stalking the pace three and four wide, drifted out a bit entering the stretch, made the lead near the eighth pole and won going away. COUNTRY CLUB SUE close up along the rail, got through to make the lead on the turn, set the pace into the stretch then was no match for the winner but finished clear for second. ADREAMFORDARLENE unhurried, had a mild late rally. COWGIRLS RULE broke in full stride to open a daylight lead soon after the start, set the pace for a half, remained a sharp threat until mid stretch then weakened. ALL'S FUR GIVEN failed to menace. FIESTY FLIRTY had brief speed. EYES AN OHES trailed and lost contact with her field on the turn.
