STORMY N CLASSY never far back while hung four wide, moved up steadily on the turn, responded under left handed urging, made the lead before the eighth pole and drew clear. TOUCH OF SUCCESS unhurried while saving ground along the rail, angled three wide at the top of the stretch, rallied determinedly and finished clear for second. CONGAWAY settled just behind the leaders then went evenly. GREAT CLIFF sprinted up along the inside to press the pace soon after the start, made the lead entering the turn, set the pace until the top of the stretch then weakened. ASIAN PROVERB failed to reach contention. INSIDER TRADING was no factor. EXPERT PRINCESS made the lead shortly after the start, set a pressured pace into the turn, had speed into the stretch, stopped and was eased through the wire and returned sore. GIFT FOR GEO trailed.
