Footnotes

RAPID REDUX made the lead three wide after a quarter, set the balance of the pace under pressure, drifted out near mid stretch and proved best under brisk handling. HATCH trailed well back for a half, circled horses on the second turn and through the stretch and was steadily cutting into the winner's advantage out in the middle of the racetrack. GOLD PROSPECT unhurried for a half, moved to the winner four wide on the second turn, pressured that one until mid stretch, was brushed and forced out by the winner then weakened. WINGS ON SPRINGS away alertly, disputed the early pace along the rail, had speed for six furlongs then flattened out. PETCH prompted the early pace while between horses, had speed into the second turn then stopped.
