LUCCIROCKINBUCCI had speed from the start four wide, made the lead before the turn, set the balance of the pace, widened into the stretch and prevailed under brisk handling. SOUP FOR TWO stalked the pace while along the rail and finished second best. PREMIER COURT had speed from the start while racing three wide and finished with good courage. P. P'S TO FOLLOW unhurried early, passed tiring rivals late. SPIDERMANDATE trailed while racing seven wide into the stretch and failed to reach a contending position. BATES STORM set the early pace while in the two path, had speed into the stretch then tired. FLASHY'S BRO was through early. KALYPTIC was always outrun and swung widest of all. The rider of SPIDERMANDATE lodged a claim of foul against the riders of SOUP FOR TWO and LUCCIROCKINBUCCI for alleged interference at the start. After reviewing the video tape replay the stewards took no action.
