WHO'S THAT ONE well placed and saved ground, angled out three wide in the upper stretch, finished well and just missed. MADAME ALI dueled with the winner on the inside, held well in the stretch. EMOTIONAL AND FREE allowed to settle while between horses, was no threat. YES LEE stalked the pace, swung wide at the top of the lane and had no rally. CLOSE THE DEAL never far back early, faltered in the stretch. DEADWOOD DAME was never a factor. T C CENTERS had an awkward start and was no threat. POLYNESIAN SUNSET was outrun.
