BATES CHOICE got away alertly, set a pressured pace from the inside under confident handling to the turn, drew off when asked, maintained a safe advantage to the wire under mild urging. BEAU'S REGAL GAL well placed while never far back, rallied to be second best while bearing in through the stretch run. CAT CROSSING went up to duel with the winner for a half but weakened in the stretch. CRYPTO CREAM raced mid pack with no response when needed. EYE WONT BACK DOWN raced evenly with no rally. KATE'S LAW was well placed early but lacked a late response. YA LATEEFAH off slow, bore in sharply after the start, was taken to the extreme outside and remained no threat while racing greenly throughout.
