TIP ALONG was never far back, rallied at the top of the stretch, angled in to the rail and was up in the final strides. PRINCESS CHRISTINE well placed early, rallied through the stretch, drew even late and just missed. PYRITE HALO pressed the pace, drew even in mid stretch, was outfinished late but held well. QUICK VERDICT unhurried early, rallied four wide in the upper stretch, steadied in mid stretch, then finished well when clear. TRULY BROADWAY set the pace, then weakened slightly in late stretch. YEAH ME allowed to settle, rallied five wide in mid stretch, drew close, then hung. NAKAGAWA well placed, faltered in the stretch. HEATHER TIME was never involed.
