TRIBUTE TO KELLY stalked the pace three wide, rallied in the upper stretch, prevailed through a long drive under left handed urging. HELLO FROM HEAVEN had good early position, rallied in the upper stretch four wide, could not get by the winner but was second best. BILLION BUCK BABY unhurried early, swung wide in upper stretch, rallied and closed willingly. FULLTIME GOGETTOR allowed to settle, saved ground and had a mild bid. ROLLINRETIREDTIRES was never far while racing four wide, had a mild bid while no threat. CARMA MOON pressed the pace and saved ground, flattened out in the stretch. OHIO'S WAY set the pace with a clear lead, faltered in the stretch. BABA BOOEY was through after a half.
